**WEEKLY HOMILY / HOMILÍA SEMANAL****Eleventh Sunday OT/Decimo Primer Domingo TO Ciclo C**

King David had committed adultery with a woman named Bathsheba and afterwards he ordered her husband to be killed in order to hide his sinful action. King David thought that everything went well. The Prophet Nathan told him that even though he was the king, he could not escape the judgment of Yahweh. David had to accept the consequences of his sin and the punishment was terrible. But the main teaching of this is that all of us have to accept and learn how to live with the consequences of our sins. But, King David received a word from God, Nathan told him: "The Lord forgives your sin. You shall not die." What a beautiful words! Today's responsorial psalm, attributed to King David, tells us the of joy of having been pardoned: "'Blessed is the one whose sins are forgiven, whose sin is covered... Rejoice the just and be glad in the Lord.'" We are included among "the just ones," not because we are perfect or we have not sinned. But rather we are counted among those just because of the grace bestowed upon us by Jesus Christ. This is what the Gospel speaks to us about. Jesus is God's forgiveness in himself. We heard about the adulterous woman who bathed the Lord's feet with her tears. This fact, scandalized many. Because they look on her as one who destroyed families, and corrupted the youth. Even though, Jesus did not minimize her sins, "that are many," but rather, he forgave her saying "Your sins are forgiven." What does it mean for Jesus to forgive sins? I read a very useful comparison in a book called "Ten Prayers God Always Says Yes To." One of the prayers is, "God, forgive me." The author of this book, Anthony DeStefano, gives this comparison: "The forgiveness of God is like a man who has lost his key and calls a locksmith to make a new one." If you are like me, the only thing that we can do while the locksmith is working is just to look on. And after a while he, the locksmith, hands you the new key, so you can open what was closed. In this comparison, the locksmith did all the work, all you and I have done is put the key through the keyhole and we opened the door. The forgiveness of the Lord is like this, Jesus does everything for us. He was born and lived among us, and he died on the cross for us. For this reason, he could tell the repentant woman: "Your sins are forgiven." And he wants to tell us in these same words. If we say this simple prayer, "Lord forgive me," we will receive the same answer, even though we are very far from being just, Jesus is the one who justified us. Naturally, the forgiveness implies a process of contrition, repentance, absolution, and reparation. But as King David and the repentant woman know, we also can know the joy of having been forgiven. May God bless you always.

El Rey David había cometido adulterio con una mujer llamada Betsabé y luego ordenó la matanza de su esposo. David pensaba que todo estaba bien. El profeta Natán le dijo a David que, a pesar de ser rey, no podía escapar el juicio de Dios. David tenía que aceptar las consecuencias de sus pecados y el castigo fue horrible. Pero eso no es el punto principal. Todos tenemos que vivir con las consecuencias de nuestros malos hechos. Sin embargo, David recibió una palabra adicional. Natán le dijo: "El Señor te perdona tu pecado. No morirás." ¡Que palabras más bellas! El Salmo de hoy - atribuido al Rey David - expresa la alegría de ser perdonado: "Dichoso el que está absuelto de su culpa, a quien le han sepultado su pecado...Alégrense, justos, y gocen con el Señor." Tu y yo estamos incluidos entre los "justos." No porque somos perfectos, no porque no hemos pecado. No, estamos contados entre los justos a causa de lo que Jesús ha hecho por nosotros. Eso es lo que dice el evangelio de hoy. Jesús en su persona es el perdón de Dios. Hoy escuchamos de la mujer que bañó los pies de Jesús con sus lágrimas de remordimiento. Esto perturbó a los otros. La vieron como una que destruye hogares y corrompe a los jóvenes. Jesús no minimizó a sus pecados - "que son muchos." Pero la perdonó. "Tus pecados te han quedado perdonados." ¿Que significa que Jesús perdona pecados? El perdón de Dios es como un hombre que pierde su llave y llama a un cerrajero para hacer una nueva. Si tu eres como yo, la única cosa que puedes hacer es mirar mientras el llavero hace tu trabajo. Después de un rato, te entrega la llave. La pones en la cerradura y - como por arte de magia - la puerta se abre. En esta comparación el cerrajero hace todo el trabajo: Tu y yo solamente la metimos y abrimos la puerta. Así es con el perdón de Dios. Jesús ya ha hecho todo por nosotros. El nació entre nosotros, vivió y murió en la cruz. Por ese motivo, le puede decir a la mujer arrepentida, "Tus pecados te han sido perdonados." Nos quiere decir las mismas palabras a nosotros. Si hacemos la oración sencilla, "Dios, perdóname," recibiremos una respuesta. A pesar de estar lejos de ser justos, Jesús nos justifica. Naturalmente ese perdón implica un proceso de contrición, satisfacción y absolución sacramental. Pero como el Rey David, como la mujer arrepentida, podemos conocer la alegría incomparable de perdón divino: "Dichoso el que está absuelto de su culpa, a quien le han sepultado su pecado...Alégrense, justos, y gocen con el Señor." Que Dios los bendiga a todos ustedes.

**RECOGER SUS NUEVOS SOBRES EN LA PARTE POSTERIOR DE LA IGLESIA.**

### **Año Jubilar de la Misericordia**

Hoy en el Jubileo por los Enfermos y las personas con Capacidades Diferentes, Jesús encuentra a una mujer que está "espiritualmente enferma". Ella no puede participar plenamente ni en la comunidad de culto y adoración de Israel ni en la sociedad. Ella lava los pies de Jesús con sus lágrimas y los seca con el cabello, ungiéndolos (Lucas 7:38) arriesgando a que Jesús quede "impuro". Sin embargo, su misericordia acoge estas acciones inapropiadas como una manifestación sincera de amor: "tus pecados son perdonados. Vete en paz" (7:48, 50). No solo ve en "paz", sino en shalom, con todo lo que esto significa, la garantía de que la vida cambia con la misericordia de Dios. Ella es una mujer excluida y "solo conocida en la ciudad" como "una mujer pecadora" (7:37). El personaje con nombre y título religioso "Simón el fariseo" (7:36, 40) la juzga muy fuertemente, pero él mismo no se juzga y por lo tanto, desaprovecha la misericordia de Dios. Este Año Jubilar de la Misericordia nos desafía a hacer un examen personal de conciencia. ¿En cuál situación nos encontramos más frecuentemente, como una persona que reconoce sus culpas o como un fariseo listo para juzgar? Jesús dice que mediante una voluntad inquebrantable para mostrar misericordia a nuestros prójimos pecadores nosotros mismos podemos obtener misericordia (ver Misericordiae Vultus, 9).
