WEEKLY HOMILY / HOMILÍA SEMANAL

Twenty-Seventh Sunday OT/Vigésimo Séptimo Domingo TO, Ciclo A

My Dear Brothers and sisters, today's Gospel is a very good example of the love of God toward us. Christ, in this passage of the gospel, gives to us a parable to see what is the intention of our heart, like he did to the Pharisees. They believed they were just and upright, but their justice was inflexible. Even though Christ shows us again His Father's justice. Humanly speaking, what should be done to those wicked tenants of today's gospel, is to kill them, they were liars, thieves and murderers. But, God is not like us. The owner of the vineyard did not grow weary of sending messengers to those wicked tenants to get what was his and lastly sent his only son. He did not give way to his anger, but saw that those tenants were getting lost in their eagerness to possess the vineyard, and did not recognize the Father's love for them. For this reason, God sent his only son to die for all of us. Because we are depositories of God's goods, and because of our sins, we believe we are entitled to possess those goods. So we have been wicked administrators and we have spent them badly. The Good News is, that the enormous debt we have with God has been canceled through the death of the innocent one, Jesus Christ. This is how God does justice, the innocent pays for the wicked, so we can obtain our justification of our sins, and as a consequence, receive Eternal Life. May God bless you always.

Mis queridos hermanos, el Evangelio de este domingo es un claro ejemplo del amor de Dios. Cristo en este pasaje del Evangelio nos propone una parábola para ver cual es la intención de nuestros corazones, al igual que con los fariseos. Estos, que se creían tan justos y honorable, pero con una justicia inflexible y totalmente humana. Y sin embargo, Cristo nos muestra otra vez la justicia del Padre celestial. Ya que humanamente, lo que habría que hacer con esos viñadores malvados, era, mandarlos a morir, por asesinos y ladrones. Pero, Dios no es así. Este Señor de la viña que no se cansaba de mandar mensajeros y por ultimo mando a su único hijo, no se dejo llevar por la ira, sino que viendo a los viñadores perdidos en su afán por tener, no pudieron reconocer el amor de su Señor. Por esto, Dios envió a su hijo a morir por todos nosotros, ya que nosotros que hemos sido estos depositarios de los bienes de Dios y que por nuestros pecados nos hemos apropiado indebidamente de ellos y no hemos sido buenos administradores sino que los hemos malgastado. La buena noticia es que esta deuda ha sido cancelada por Cristo, él, el Hijo único ha pagado todas nuestras faltas. Esta es la justicia de Dios Padre, que el inocente ha sufrido la culpa de los culpables, para que podamos obtener por Cristo la justificación y el perdón de nuestros pecados y así recibir en herencia la "Vida Eterna." Que Dios me los bendiga a todos ustedes, y a sus familias y amigos.
